- All incoming and outgoing requests for charitable contributions/sponsorships, in-kind services, and/or company volunteer support will be coordinated and administered by i-80 Gold Community Relations.
- All requests must be made in writing and submitted to i-80 Gold Community Relations for research, review, and final disposition. Community Relations will communicate directly with agencies regarding all requests and coordinate any follow up documentation, and/or collateral activities such as ads, tickets, invitations, banners, etc.

To assist in the development of sustainable prosperity, our project sites and mines are actively involved in initiatives to better the communities in which we operate. Because the requests are so great and varied across our communities, guidelines have been implemented to assist as many organizations as possible.

### Guidelines

If you are interested in seeking a donation, please review the following guidelines before submitting your request. These guidelines will be used in reviewing requests for charitable contributions and sponsorships and company volunteer initiatives for i-80 Gold:

- Priority will be given to Nevada-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, 501(c)(4) social welfare organizations, and 501(c)(6) business leagues will be considered for charitable contributions, sponsorships, volunteer support, or in-kind donations.
- The contribution must be used for the benefit of at least one of the following purposes:
  - **Education & Workforce Development:** Investing in and providing educational and career opportunities to students and community members.
  - **Community Investment:** Positively impacting the communities we live and work in by contributing our "time, talent, and treasure" for economic development and to drive social impact.
  - **Environmental:** Building and maintaining respectful, long-lasting, and collaborative relationships with host communities, while being responsible stewards of our environment and resources.
- All corporate charitable contributions, sponsorships, and in-kind services will promote our business goals, create positive visibility, and demonstrate social responsibility.

- All requests will be reviewed by the Community Relations Manager with formal recommendation by the President and Chief Operating Officer.
- Priority will be given to organizations that foster growth and development within the Nevada communities we support- Eureka County, Eureka, Humboldt County, Winnemucca, Lander County, Battle Mountain, and Reno.
- Donations will be made on a relative need basis. Groups with greater need will be given priority.

Many factors are included in the evaluation of these proposals. If more information about a specific organization is needed, a member of i-80 Gold will contact the organization. During the review process, we may arrange a meeting or site visit to discuss the project. i-80 Gold will make every effort to process your request in a timely manner. A decision to deny a request does not imply that the applicant's program is not needed or worthy, but simply that it does not fall within our giving guidelines, priorities, or that funds are not available.
