

i-80 Gold Ruby Hill Exploration Teach-in Session

Reno, Nevada, November 14, 2022 – **i-80 GOLD CORP. (TSX:IAU) (NYSE:IAUX) (“i-80”, or the “Company”)** will hold a Ruby Hill “teach-in” session on November 15, 2022, commencing at 8:30am ET.
