i-80 Gold Corp is seeking a motivated and proactive individual to fill the position of **Underground Construction Manager** for our Ruby Hill Mine located in Eureka, NV. This position will be the project champion responsible for advancing the underground mine through permitting, construction, advanced exploration, and into production.

Site: Ruby Hill

Ruby Hill is part of the historic Eureka district with gold discoveries dating back to 1864. The Archimedes pit was mined primarily oxide heap leach ore from 1997 to 2021. Residual leaching of the pad is ongoing. The property is host to multiple high-grade deposits of both precious and base metals. The company is currently permitting the "426" and "Blackjack" deposits for underground development and mining as these are the two deposits nearest to the surface and existing infrastructure. The plan consists of constructing two portals and support facilities inside of the Archimedes pit and first mining the 426 deposit while drifting to and further delineating the blackjack deposit. The Underground Construction Manager will be responsible for building this new underground mine including surface support infrastructure as well as aiding in the permitting process.

As the underground mine is developed, drilling from surface will continue to discover and delineate new deposits. Ultimately i-80 expects to mine multiple underground deposits simultaneously at the Ruby Hill property.

Responsibilities:

- Champion safety and environmental stewardship for the project
- Own and execute the project development schedule
- Develop requests for proposals, analyze bids and select contractors in collaboration with i-80 technical and financial staff

- Lead the project employees and ensure that contractors, consultants, and all other visitors are oriented and can work safely and efficiently
- Build a technical and support team for the underground project
- Manage existing and growing workforce for the underground project
- Work with regulatory and other government entities (e.g., MSHA, BLM, NDEP, County, City/Town, etc.) to advance the project
- Lead budgeting forecasting for the underground project in collaboration with site and i-80 management
- Frequent interaction with i-80 technical, executive, and financial staff
